

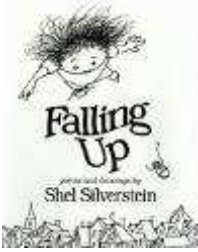

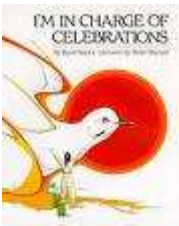
A young boy describes the favorite places that he shares with his family on his grandparents' farm and in the nearby countryside.

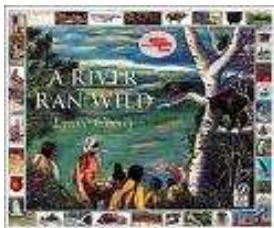

A dweller in the desert celebrates a triple rainbow, a chance encounter with a coyote, and other wonders of the wilderness.



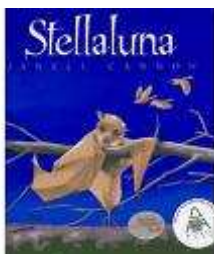

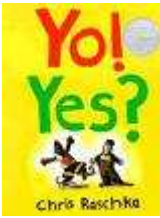
An environmental history of the Nashua River, from its discovery by Indians through the polluting years of the Industrial Revolution to the ambitious clean-up that revitalized it.



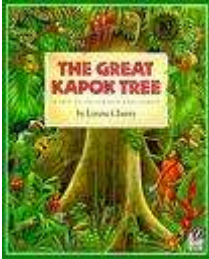

After she falls headfirst into a bird's nest, a baby bat is raised like a bird until she is reunited with her mother. Users can read along with the story, play, or learn about bats.



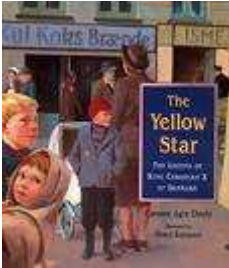

The many different animals that live in a great kapok tree in the Brazilian rainforest try to convince a man with an ax of the importance of not cutting down their home.



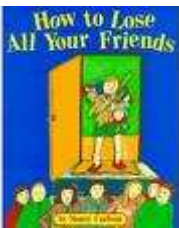
